

# Policy – Official DSMRA Activities

## Policy Statement

Only volunteer members, full or temporary, who are contributing to an official DSMRA activity are protected by DSMRA's volunteer member indemnity insurance.

## Principles

The DSMRA primarily undertakes motorcycle riding activities. Other activities such as, but not limited to, assisting with rides, bike and/or person recoveries, meetings, fund raising and charity events can also be an official DSMRA activity.

To be an official DSMRA activity, and therefore have indemnity insurance coverage for volunteer members, including temporary volunteer members, supporting that activity, the activity must:

- be approved by a subcommittee Branch
  - if the activity is a ride, by liaising with the local ride coordinator in the first instance
  - it may be beneficial to have the activity listed on the DSMRA calendar if participation is not to be restricted
- have all participants provide a completed Recognition of Risk form if appropriate for that activity, eg a ride
- have a sign on/off form where all participants sign on and off the activity if appropriate for that activity, eg a ride
- have all records stored in accordance with DSMRA's Records Management Procedure
